

Percentage of Employees in Wyoming by Full- and Part-Time Status, 2003 and 2006






As a share of total employment, the number of part-time workers in Wyoming was 15.4% higher in 2006 than in 2003 (an increase of 3.5 percentage points).


Average Percentage of Wyoming Full- and Part-Time Employees Who Were Offered Selected Insurance Plans and Chose to Enroll, 2003 and 2006
