Initial and Continued Claims Increase from December




Figure 1: Total Number of Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims for Wyoming by Year and Month, January 2011 to January 2021

nemployment Insurance (UI) claims in Wyoming followed their usual seasonal trends from December 2020 to January 2021, with initial claims increasing 23.8% and continued weeks claimed increasing 9.3%. The volume of claims remained much greater than pre-COVID-19 pandemic levels. See Figure 1 and Figure 2, page 4.

Initial Claims

Wyoming had 5,870 initial claims (see Definitions, page 9) in January, up from 4,740 in December (1,130 more claims, or 23.8%). Nearly all industries showed double-digit percentage increases over the month, with the exception of manufacturing (-4.4%) and education & health services (-2.6%). The industries that




Figure 3: Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims by Major Industry in Wyoming, December 2020 and January 2021

saw the greatest over-the-month increases included leisure & hospitality (107 more claims, or 17.7%), transportation, warehousing, & utilities (104, or 68.0%), and retail trade (100, or 45.9%). All levels of government saw over-the-month increases in initial claims, led by local government (74, or 70.5%). See Table 1 (page 5) and Figure 3 (page 6).

All counties saw over-the-month increases in initial claims, with the




Figure 4: Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims by County of Residence, December 2020 and January 2021

exception of Niobrara County (-4 claims, or -36.4%). The counties with the greatest increases were Teton (152, or 170.8%), Laramie (116, or 17.7%), and Sweetwater (111, or 33.6%). The number of out-of-state claimants increased by 160, or 24.1%. See Figure 4 (page 6) and Table 3 (page 9).


Continued Claims

The total number of continued weeks claimed increased from 32,057 to 35,032 (2,975, or 9.3%). The total number of unique claimants increased from 8,895 to 11,450 (2,555, or 28.7%). See Figure 2 and Table 2, page 7.




Figure 5: Continued Unemployment Insurance Claims by Major Industry in Wyoming, December 2020 and January 2021

Continued claims increased in most

private sector industries, including construction (2,491, or 38.4%), mining (802, or 26.3%), and professional & business services (539, or 20.8%). Continued claims increased in federal (151, or 19.5%), state (25, or 10.3%), and local (52, or 5.3%) government. See Table 2, page 7, and Figure 5, page 8.

Continued claims increased in most counties, led by Natrona (1,013, or 16.7%), Laramie (441, or 11.8%), and Campbell (429, or 17.2%) counties. Teton County showed the greatest over-the-month decrease in continued claims (-559, or -42.8%). Continued claims for out-of-state claimants increased by 288 weeks (5.1%). 


Figure 6: Continued Unemployment Insurance Claims by County of Residence in Wyoming, December 2020 and January 2021

Box: Definitions

Initial Claim: An initial claim is filed by an unemployed individual after a separation from an employer. The claim requests a determination of basic eligibility for the Unemployment Insurance benefits.

Continued Weeks Claimed: The number of weeks of UI benefits claimed during the reference period. An unemployed individual who has already filed an initial claim and who has experienced a week of unemployment and then filed a continued claim to claim benefits for that week of unemployment.
