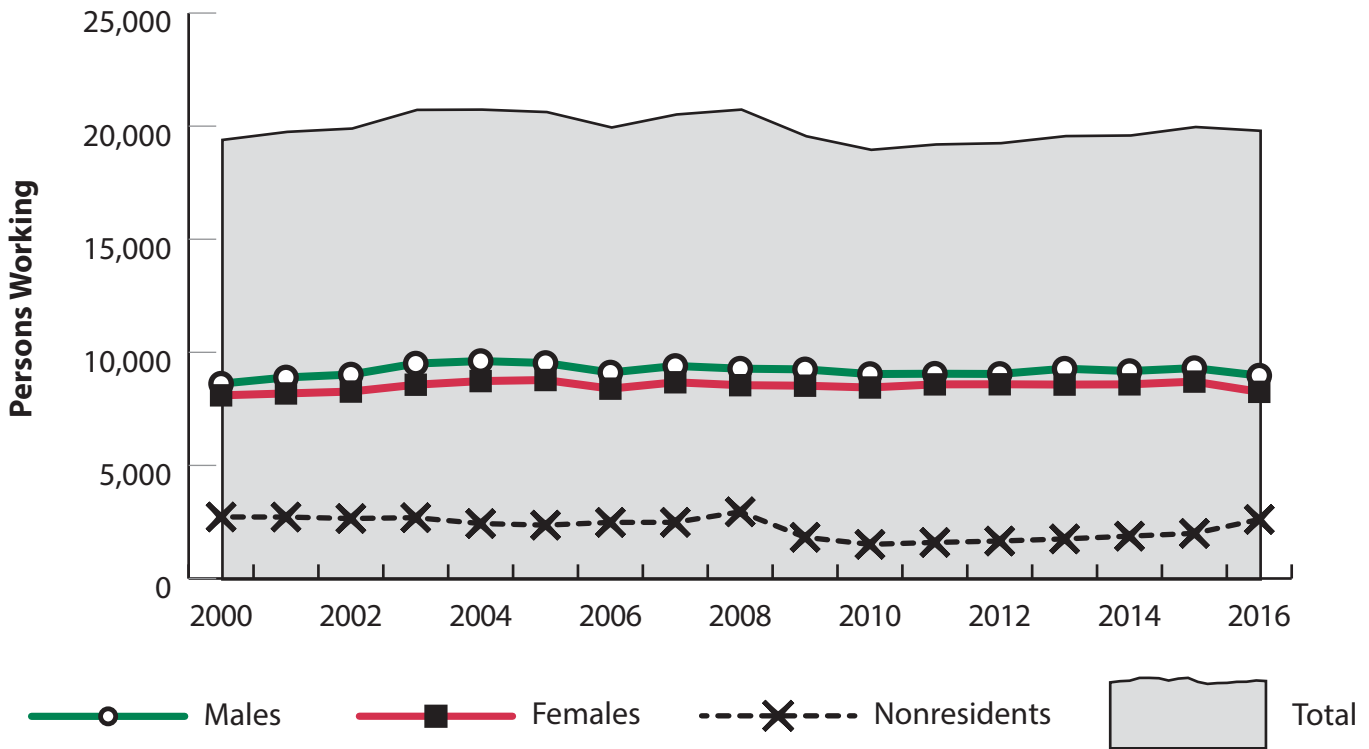
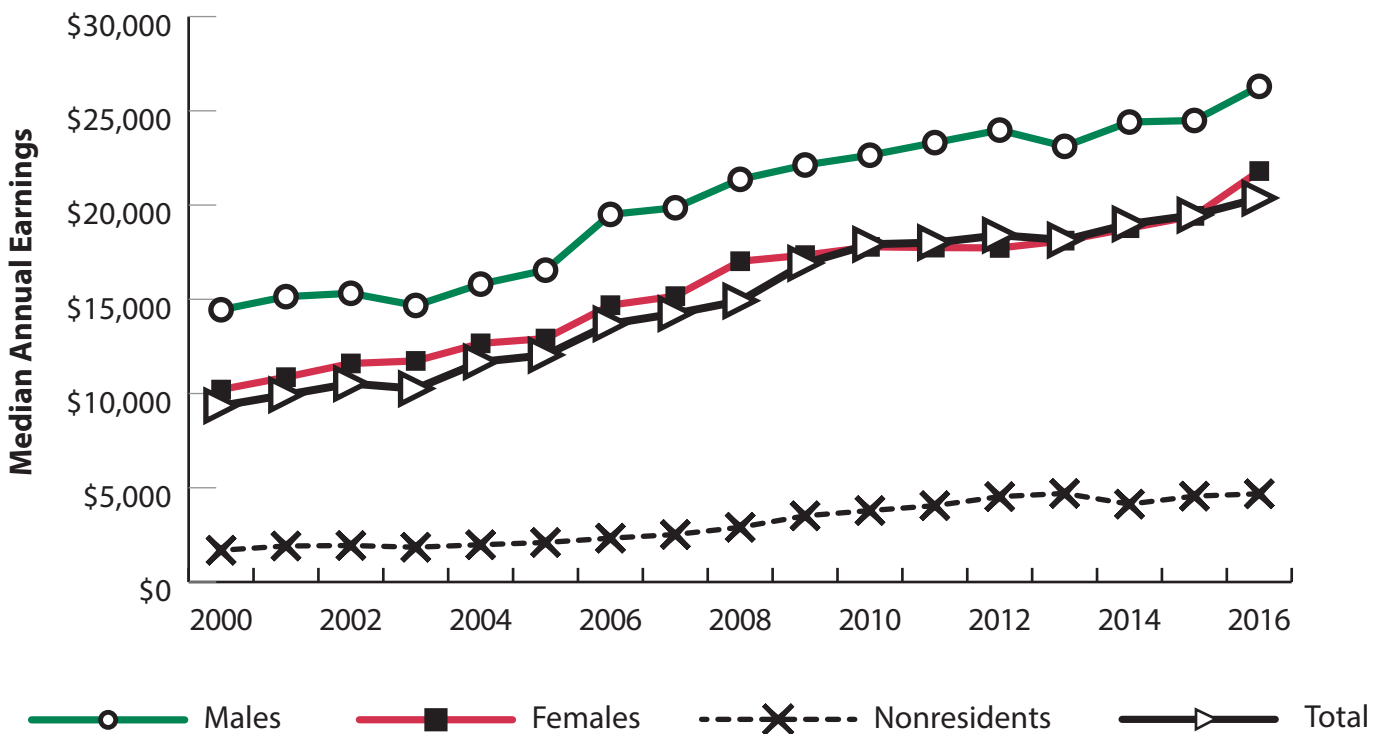


Persons Working and Average Earnings by Gender in Albany County, WY, 2000-2016
