






Figure: Persons Working by Gender, 2018

Total = 39,887




Figure: Persons Working by Age, 2018




Figure: Persons Working in Retail Trade (NAICS 44-45) in Wyoming at Any Time by Gender, 2000-2018




Figure: Persons Working in Retail Trade (NAICS 44-45) in Wyoming at Any Time by Age, 2000-2018
