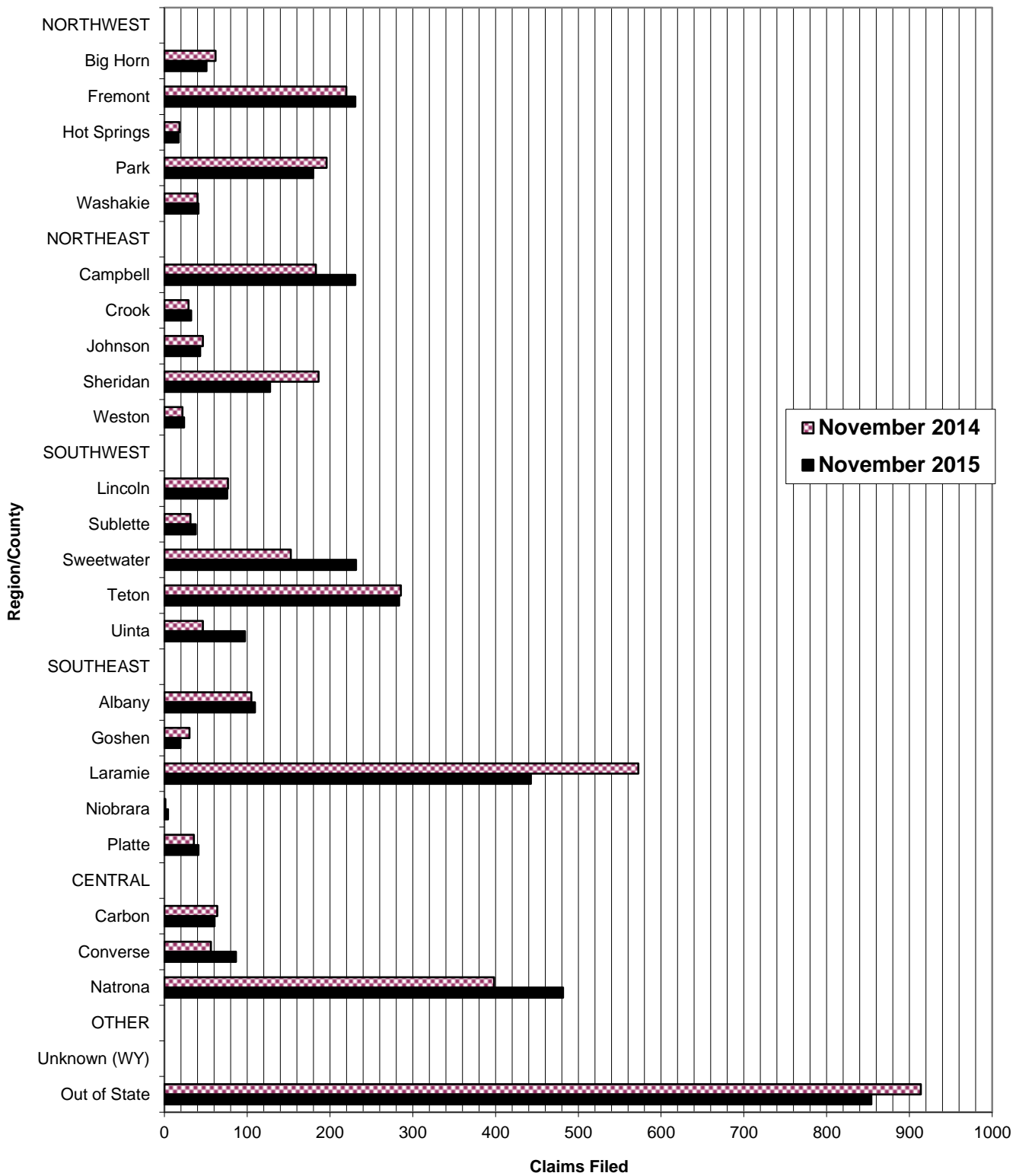
Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims by Major Industry



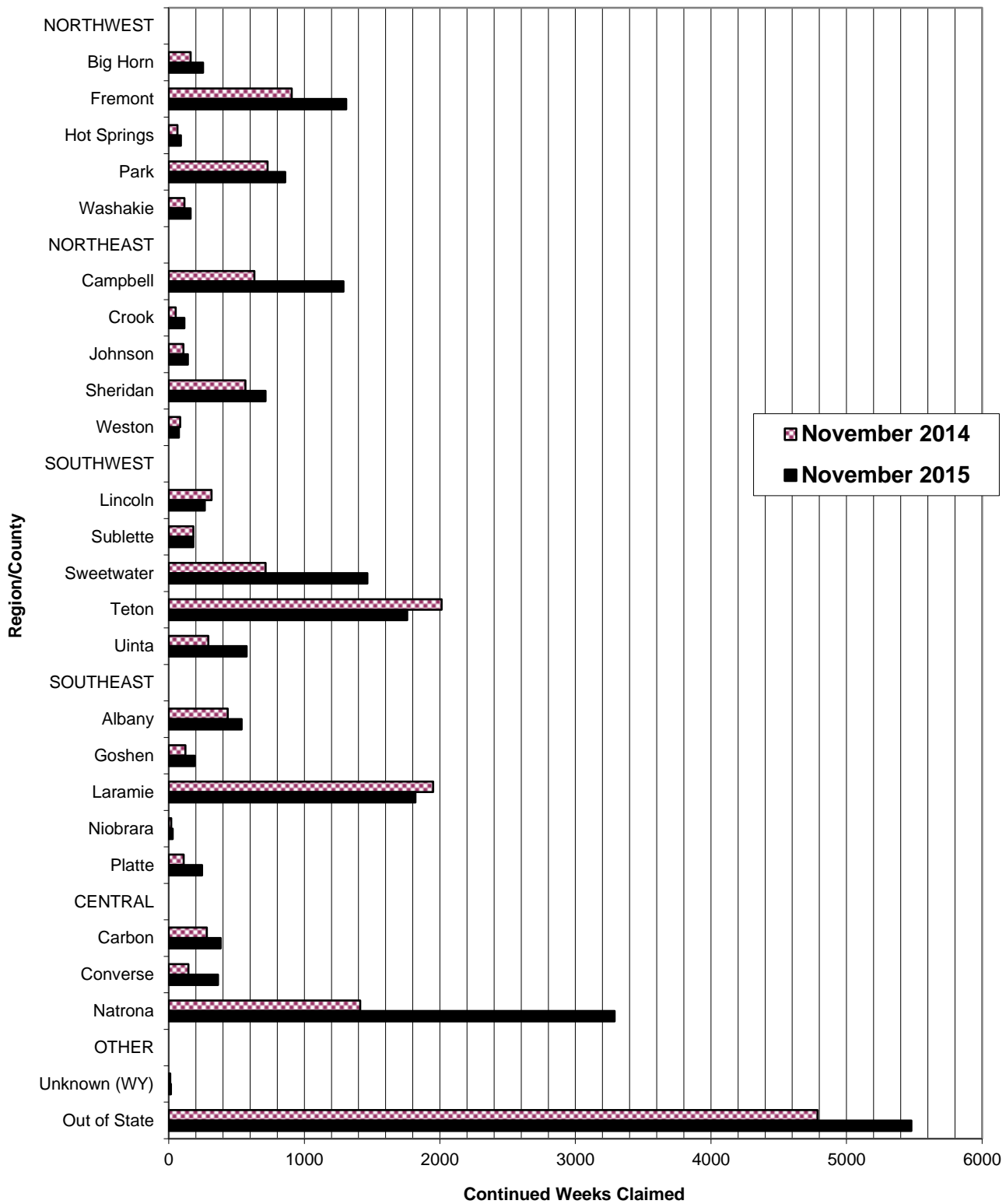
Continued Unemployment Insurance Claims by Major Industry
