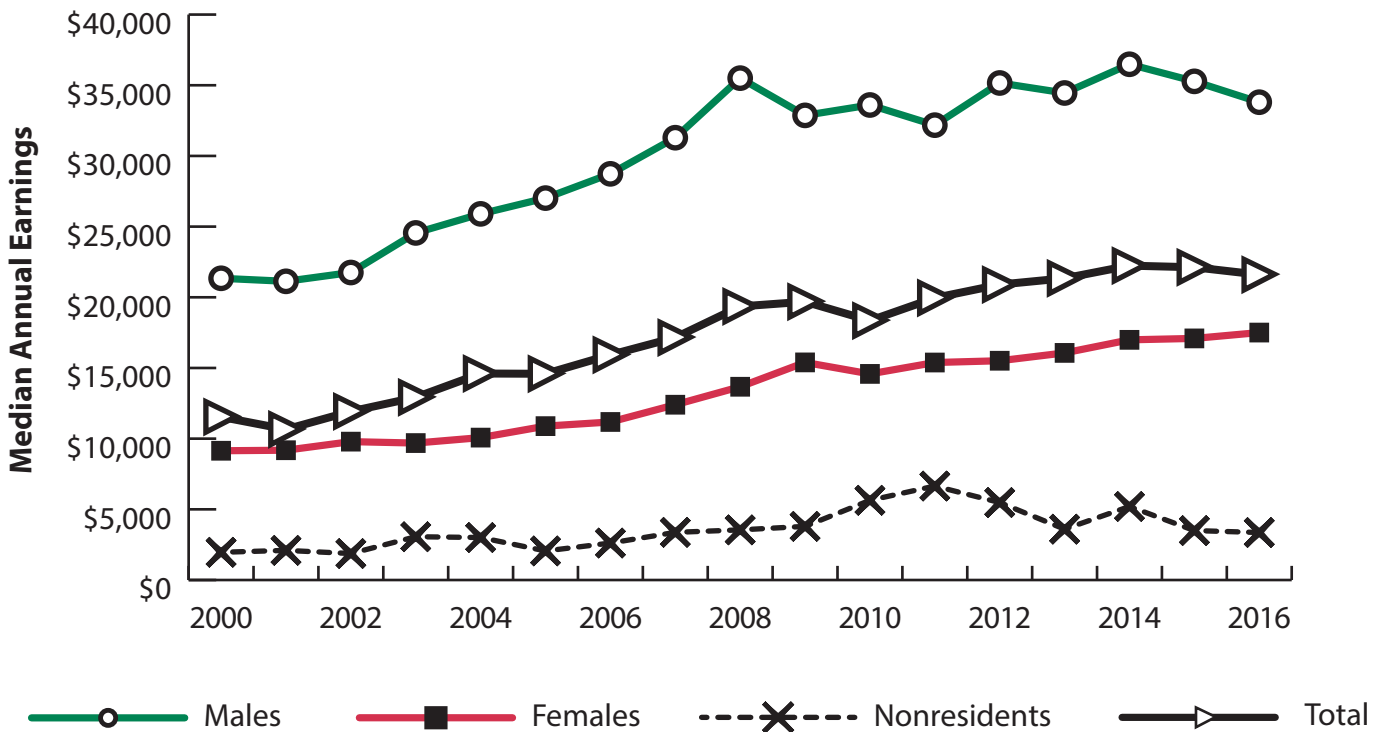


Persons Working and Average Earnings by Gender in Weston County, WY, 2000-2016
