






Figure: Persons Working by Gender, 2018




Figure: Persons Working by Age, 2018




Figure: Persons Working in Professional & Business Services (NAICS 54-55) in Wyoming at Any Time by Gender, 2000-2018




Figure: Persons Working in Professional & Business Services (NAICS 54-55) in Wyoming at Any Time by Age, 2000-2018
