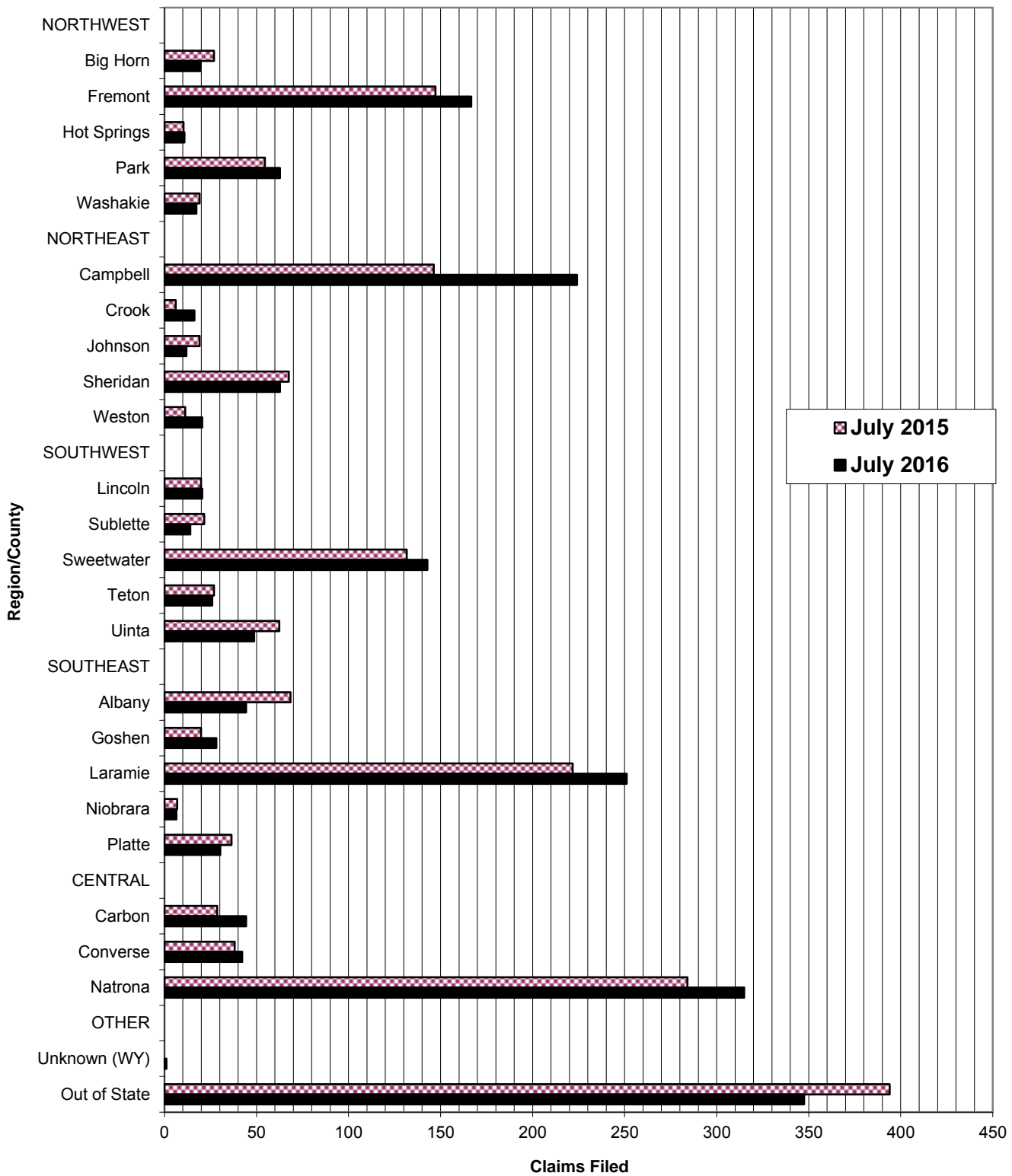
### Initial Unemployment Insurance Claims by Major Industry



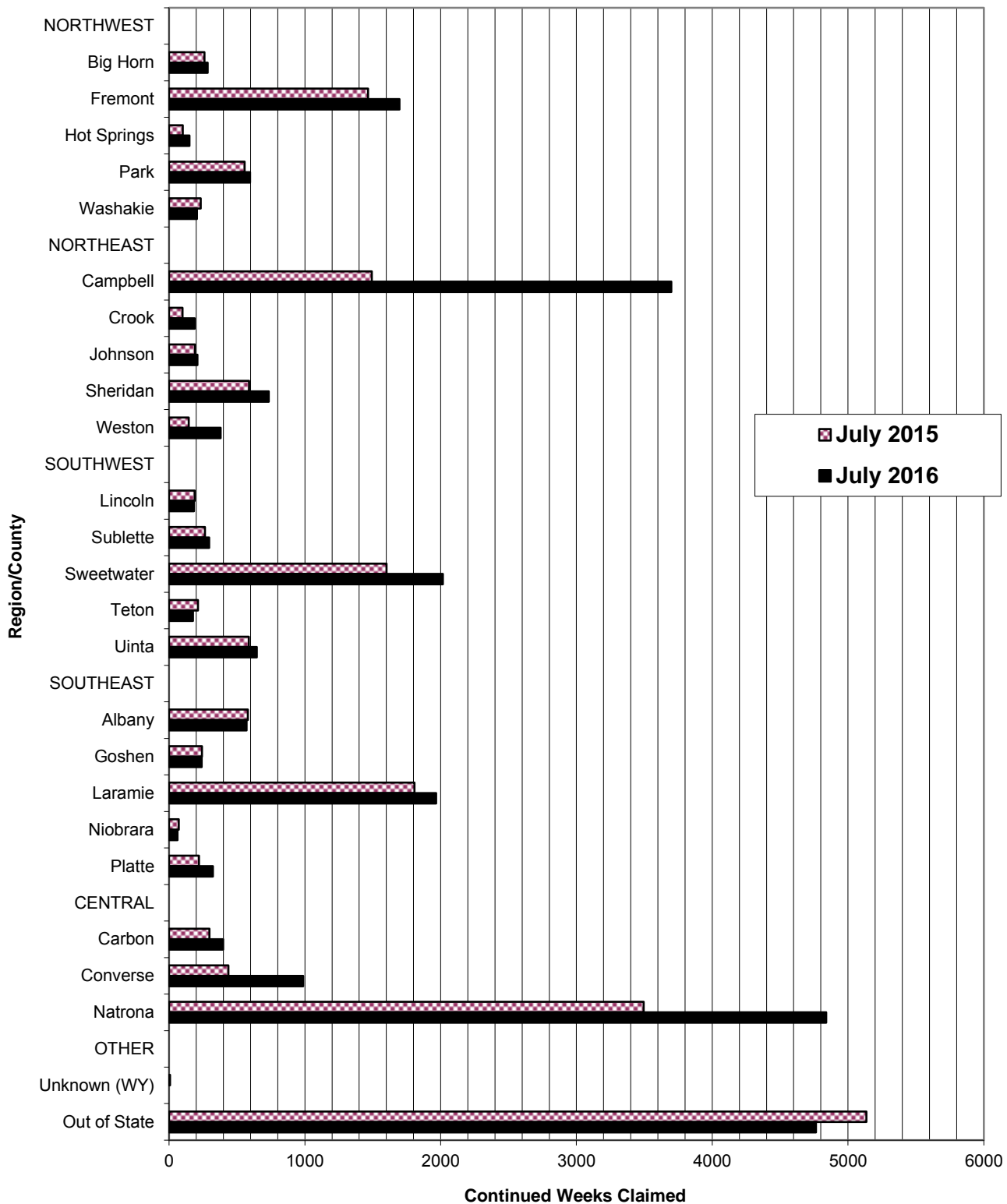
### Continued Unemployment Insurance Claims by Major Industry
