Wyoming Interstate and Intercounty Commuting Report, 2018Q1

For several years the Research & Planning (R&P) section of the Wyoming Department of Workforce Services has published intercounty commuting patterns that illustrate how many individuals commute to or from another county for work. A new model developed by R&P also provides data on interstate commuting. Using this new model, R&P was able to identify commuting patterns for Wyoming residents working in eight other states: Colorado, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Ohio, South Dakota, Texas, and Utah. Commuting from one state of residence to another state of employment is referred to as *interstate commuting* (see Box 1, page 4). Historical commuting data are available online at <https://doe.state.wy.us/LMI/commute.htm>.

The new commuting pattern model was created by linking several administrative databases, including Wyoming Wage Records, the Wyoming Department of Transportation (WYDOT) driver's license file, wage records from partner states with which R&P has data-sharing agreements, driver's license files from Colorado, and more. By linking these databases, R&P was able to determine place of residence and place of employment.

Wage records represent an individual's wage history based on employers' quarterly wage and employment reports to the Unemployment Insurance (UI) tax section of the Wyoming Department of Workforce Services, and provide a count of the number of people working in Wyoming. Bullard (2015) noted that UI covered

employment represents approximately 91.5% of Wyoming's total wage and salary employment.

Place of residence was identified using driver's license files that were obtained through memoranda of understanding with WYDOT and the Colorado Department of Transportation. A person's residence across time was used to identify his or her place of residence. Expired and surrendered driver's licenses were excluded from this research. R&P was able to identify state and county of residence for individuals from Colorado and Wyoming. Place of residence was not available for workers from other states, so those individuals are listed as unknown on the tables in this article.

Place of employment was determined from wage records for Wyoming and the eight previously mentioned partner states. If an individual worked for an employer with multiple jobsites, place of employment was assigned to the most likely employer location based on distance, county of employer unit, and county of residence, among other variables. Places of employment were not mutually exclusive; for example, an individual who had wages in Wyoming and Colorado would be counted twice.

This report provides interstate and intercounty commuting data for each Wyoming county for 2018Q1, the most recent quarter for which R&P had wage records from partner states. More current

Box 1: Commuting Definitions

Place of residence. The state or county in which an individual resides, based on Wyoming driver's license files and other administrative databases. Place of residence is available for Wyoming and Colorado residents.

County of employment. The location of the employer for which an individual works, based on Unemployment Insurance (UI) tax files.

Intercounty employment. The movement of individuals from one Wyoming county of residence to another Wyoming county of employment.

Interstate commuting. The movement of individuals from one state of residence to another state of employment.

Partner states. Eight states with which Research & Planning has data-sharing agreements: Colorado, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, Ohio, South Dakota, Texas, and Utah.

Inflow. Workers commuting a place of work from another place of residence.

Outflow. Workers commuting from a place of residence to another place of employment.

Net flow. Inflow minus outflow.

Nonresidents. Individuals for whom demographic data are not available, including residents of other states or countries.

Unknown. The location of the work site (county of employment) could not be determined. For example, As shown in the Figure, Hypothetical Pat lives in Uinta County, Wyoming, but commutes to work for Imaginary Construction in Utah.




Figure: Hypothetical Example of Intercounty Commuting

interstate commuting patterns will be published once the data become available to R&P.

Interstate Commuting: 2018Q1

As shown in Table A, more than 17,000 Wyoming residents had wages in another state in 2018Q1. The states with the greatest numbers of Wyoming commuters were Colorado (5,723), Utah (3,066), Texas (2,578), and Montana (2,467). Table A and Figure A also show the average quarterly wage for Wyoming residents by state of employment. The total average wage for Wyoming residents was \$10,473, while commuters to some states earned noticeably less, such as South Dakota (\$6,050), Nebraska (\$8,077), and Utah (\$8,964). This indicates that Wyoming residents commute to other states for reasons other than higher wages. Kofoed (in press) noted that some

of the reasons individuals commute for work include proximity to another state or county, economic conditions,

the availability of jobs, housing costs, the industrial makeup of a particular area, and more. A more




Figure A: Average Quarterly Wage for Wyoming Residents by State of Employment, 2018Q1

in-depth article on reasons for commuting will be published in a forthcoming issue of *Wyoming Labor Force Trends*.

Outflow

For the purposes of this article, *outflow* refers to Wyoming residents with wages in another county or state, such as a resident of Laramie County commuting to Colorado for work, or a resident of Lincoln County commuting to Sweetwater County. Table B shows the number of Wyoming residents who commuted to another county or state by county of residence in 2018Q1. Overall,

16.7% of all Wyoming residents had wages in another county or state: 10.4% in another county and 6.3% in another state. Counties with a noticeably higher proportion of residents commuting to another state included Uinta (11.9%), Goshen (11.7%), and Crook (10.2%). Many of Wyoming's least populous counties had the greatest percentage of residents commuting to another county or state, such as Crook (47.1%) and Weston (37.3%) counties.

The commuting patterns presented in this report also provide detailed data at the county level. For example, as previously

mentioned, Uinta County had the greatest proportion of workers with wages in another state in 2018Q1 (11.9%); in addition, 14.1% had wages in another Wyoming county. As shown in Table 21b on page 30 of this report, 8.0% of all Uinta County residents with wages commuted to Utah for work. The average quarterly wage for Uinta County residents commuting to Utah was \$8,743, noticeably less than the average wages for Uinta County residents working in their home county (\$10,043) and those working in Sweetwater County (\$18,889). This may be an indication that Uinta County residents aren't necessarily traveling to Utah for higher

wages, and that other factors influence their decisions to travel out of state for work.

Inflow

Inflow refers to individuals commuting to work in Wyoming from another place of residence, such as a resident of Colorado commuting to Natrona County for work, or a person from another country who had wages in Teton County. Of the 288,596 individuals with wages in Wyoming in 2018Q1, 22.0% commuted from another county, state, or country of residence (see Table C). More than 35,000 (12.2%)

commuted from another state or country, while more than 28,000 (9.8%) commuted from another county.

Teton County, which has historically relied on large numbers of out-of-state workers to fill jobs in the leisure & hospitality industry, had the greatest inflow rate at 41.4%: 32.7% from another state or country and 8.7% from another Wyoming county. Many counties with small populations also had high rates of

inflow, such as Niobrara (34.6%), Crook (33.9%), and Sublette (32.1%) counties.

Overall, \$48.4 million of Teton County's total wages (22.2%) were paid to commuters from other states and countries (see Table 20A, page 29). The average wage for commuters in Teton County was \$6,943, or 32.2% less than the county's average wage; nonresident workers are often hired to fill temporary or seasonal jobs, often with lower wages.

Net Flow

Finally, *net flow* refers to the difference in inflow and outflow, and is calculated by subtracting outflow from inflow. A positive net flow (*net inflow*) indicates there were more jobs in a county than workers, while a negative net flow (*net outflow*) indicates there were more workers than jobs.

Many of the counties with the greatest net inflow were those with the largest populations and greatest numbers of jobs, such as Laramie, Natrona, Campbell, Sweetwater, and Albany, along with Teton County, which attracts a large number of nonresident workers.

Two of the counties with the greatest net outflow were in the southwest corner of the state along the Utah border: Lincoln (-1,255) and Uinta (-713). As shown in Table B (see page 6), Uinta County had the highest proportion of residents working in another state (11.9%), while Lincoln County had a high percentage of residents working in another county (26.3%).

Conclusion

In Wyoming, people often live in one

county and work in another. In addition, Wyoming residents sometimes travel to another state for work, and employers rely on out-of-state workers, particularly to fill seasonal and part-time jobs.

The new model developed by R&P provides a large amount of data that allow a better understanding of interstate and intercounty commuting in Wyoming.






