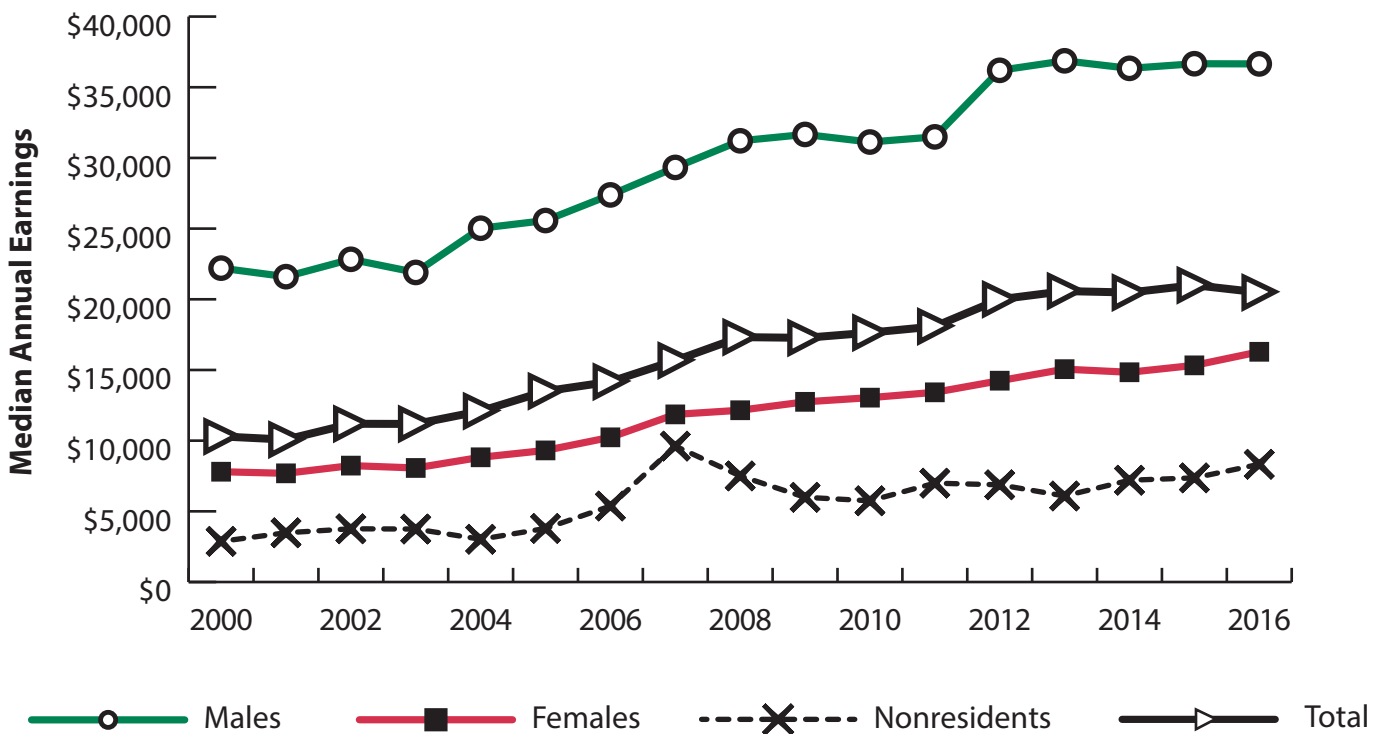


Persons Working and Average Earnings by Gender in Lincoln County, WY, 2000-2016
