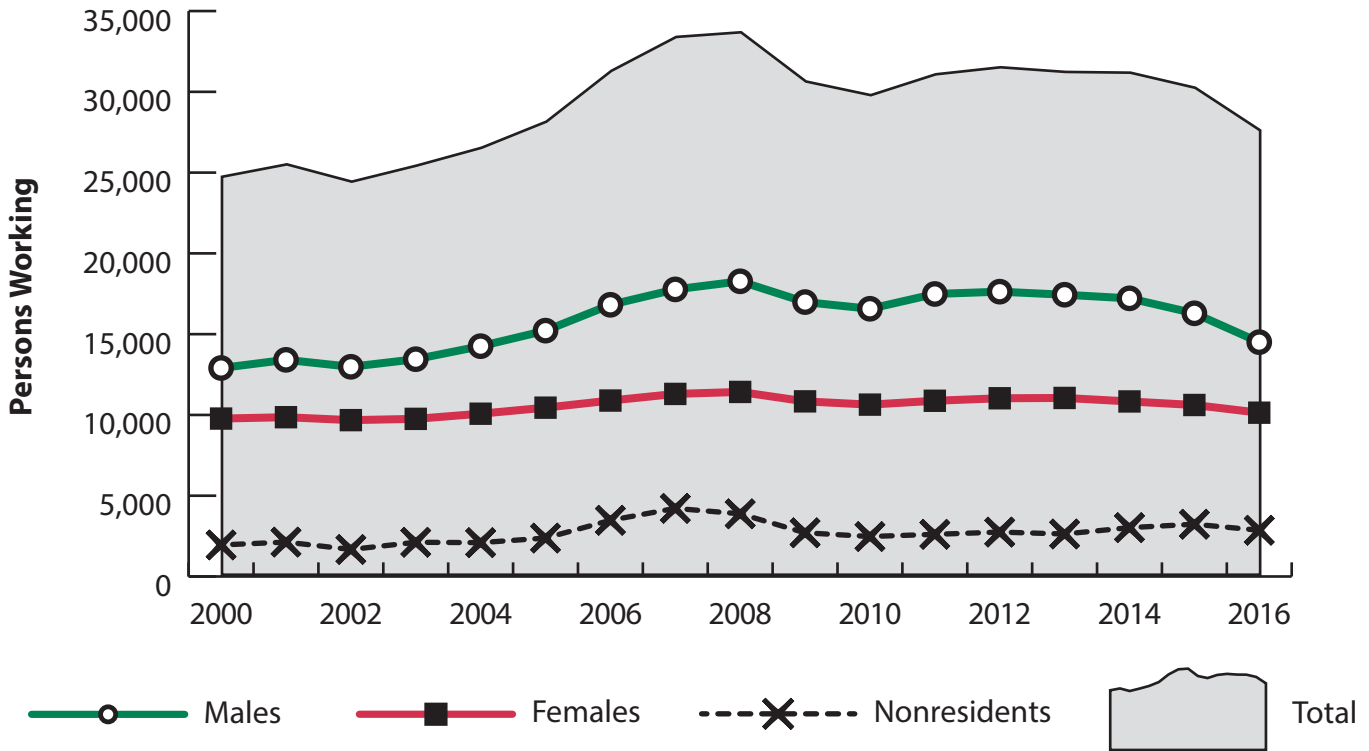
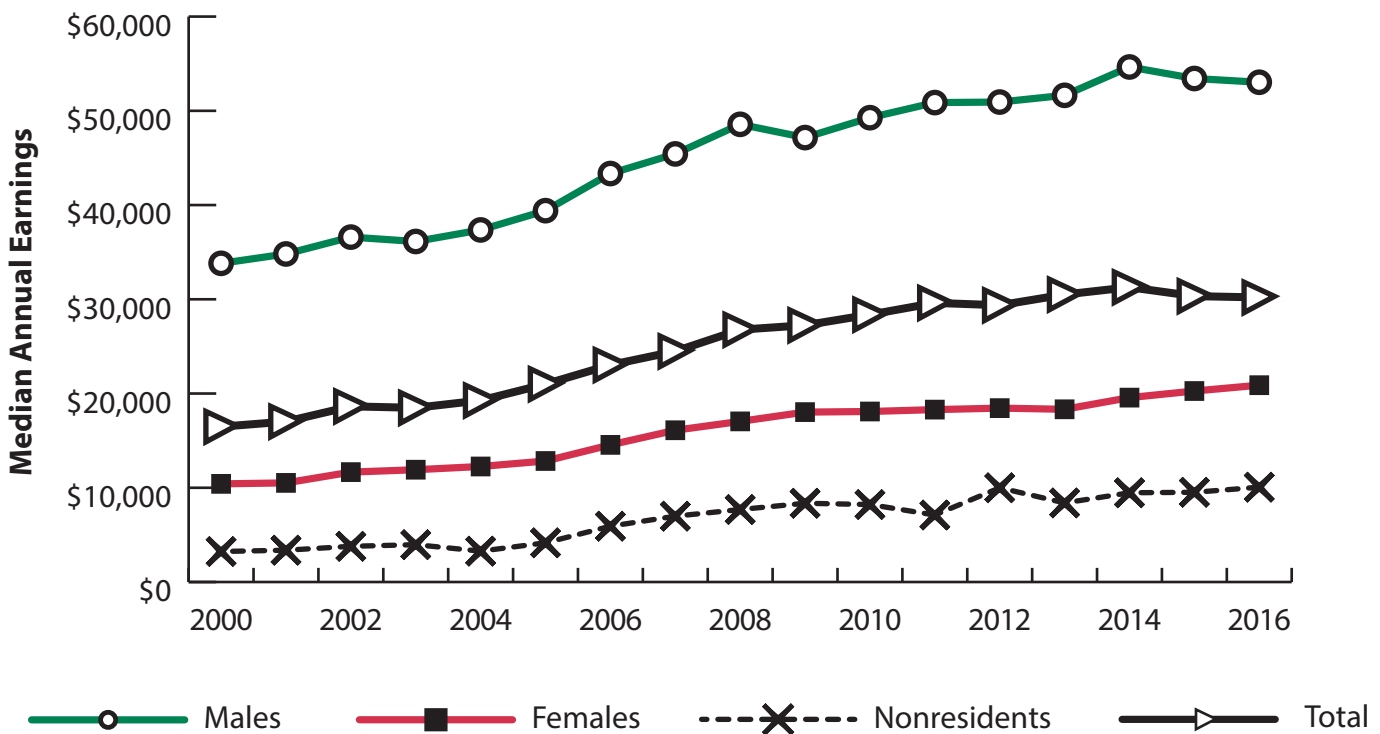


Persons Working and Average Earnings by Gender in Sweetwater County, WY, 2000-2016
