



Figure: Average Annual Wages by Gender, 2017




Figure: Persons Working by Gender, 2017




Figure: Persons Working by Age, 2017




Figure: Persons Working in Goshen County at Any Time by Gender, 2000-2017




Figure: Persons Working in Goshen County at Any Time by Age, 2000-2017

Wages for Persons Working in Goshen County by Gender, 2000-2017




Figure: Average Annual Wage for Persons Working in Goshen County at Any Time by Age, 2000-2017




Figure: Women's Average Annual Wages as a Percent of Men's Wages for Persons Working in Goshen County at Any Time by Age, 2000-2017
