






Figure: Persons Working by Gender, 2017




Figure: Persons Working by Age, 2017




Figure: Persons Working in Mining, Including Oil & Gas (NAICS 21) in Wyoming at Any Time by Gender, 2000-2017




Figure: Persons Working in Mining, Including Oil & Gas (NAICS 21) in Wyoming at Any Time by Age, 2000-2017




