


Figure: Average Annual Wages by Gender, 2017




Figure: Persons Working by Gender, 2017




Figure: Persons Working by Age, 2017




Figure: Persons Working in Health Care & Social Assistance (NAICS 62) in Wyoming at Any Time by Gender, 2000-2017




Figure: Persons Working in Health Care & Social Assistance (NAICS 62) in Wyoming at Any Time by Age, 2000-2017




Figure: Average Annual Wage for Persons Working in Health Care & Social Assistance (NAICS 62) in Wyoming at Any Time by Age, 2000-2017


