Introduction to Health Care Dashboards

he Research & Planning (R&P) section of the Wyoming Department of Workforce Services was asked by the Wyoming Legislative Services Office (LSO) to prepare dashboards for more than 40 licensed health care occupations in Wyoming.

Occupations are classified using the Standard Occupation Classification (SOC) system, a federal standardized coding system that is used to categorize jobs based on the job's duties and activities. This classification system allows jobs to be grouped together for ease of data collection, statistical calculations, and reporting purposes (see the box on page 4).

The data contained in these dashboards were compiled from several sources, many of which are available on R&P's website (https://doe.state.wy.us/LMI).

The data pertaining to the licensing requirements for each occupation is available in the Directory of Licensed Occupations in Wyoming, which is updated biennially and is available at http://doe.state.wy.us/lmi/dir_lic/licoccs-2017.pdf.

Employment and wage data from the Wyoming Wage Survey, also known as the Occupational Employment Statistics (OES) Survey, are collected twice a year. The data estimates from this program include wage and employment numbers for the state as a whole, all counties and all substate regions, as well as by industry. The wage estimates are updated

in between estimate releases using the Employment Cost Index (ECI). For the purposes of this project, these estimates are updated to March 2019. OES data can be found at https://doe.state.wy.us/LMI/LEWISMarch2019ECI/toc000.htm.

The New Hires Job Skills Survey is a survey that was created by R&P to collect data about the types of jobs being filled in the state. This questionnaire is sent to random employers on a quarterly basis and asks questions about the job held by an individual employee who had not worked for that employer in the past (referred to as a new hire). Data collected about the job include occupation, wages and benefits, and job skills needed for that particular job. The most recent data available are from 2017. The results of this survey are updated and released annually and can be found at https://doe.state. wy.us/LMI/newhires.htm.

R&P produces short-term industry and occupational projections every other year. These estimates show the employment change projected to occur during the two year period of reference. These tables show the number of employees at the beginning of the projection period, the projected number of workers estimated to be employed by the end of the projection period, and the numeric and percentage changes based on growth, along with annual openings due to persons exiting the workforce or transferring jobs. The most recent short-term projections data are for 2018 to 2020, and these tables can be found at https://doe.state.wy.us/ LMI/projections/2019/Short_Term_ Projections_2018-20.htm.

Similarly, R&P produces long-term projections for both industries and occupations at the statewide and substate region levels. These estimates are released in a revolving two-year period, with statewide estimates released one year and substate estimates released the next. These estimates include the employment numbers at the beginning of the reference period, the projected employment at the end of the 10-year period, the numeric and percent changes, and the number of projected jobs openings due to persons

exiting the workforce or transferring jobs. The most recent long-term projections available are from 2016 to 2026, and these tables are available at https://doe.state.wy.us/LMI/projections/2018/WY_long_term_projections_2016-2026.pdf.

Finally, projections data from surrounding states were obtained from ProjectionsCentral. com to compare job growth, projected annual openings, and wages in Wyoming to Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, South Dakota, and Utah.

Box 1: SOC Coding

Occupations are classified using the federal Standard Occupation Classification (SOC) system, which allows for the ease of data collection, statistical calculations, and reporting purposes. Each job is assigned a six-digit code based on the activities done by workers holding the job. These codes can be grouped together in several ways, which are based on the number of digits used from the code.

The first two digits of the SOC code are referred to as the *major group*, the first three digits of the code are referred to as a *minor group*, the first five digits of a code are called a *broad group*, and the entire six-digit SOC code is called a *detailed occupation*. As an example, nursing assistants are SOC coded 31-1014 at the detailed occupation level, but can also be categorized as nursing, psychiatric, or home health aides at the broad group level (31-1010), nursing, psychiatric, or home health aides at the minor group level (31-1000), and healthcare support occupations at the major group level (31-1000).

There are 867 available detailed occupation codes, but sometimes several jobs are will be categorized under one code because their job duties are similar and there are not separate codes for each. For example, in these dashboards, certified medication assistants and nursing assistants are both given the SOC code 31-1014 (nursing assistants) because their job duties and training requirements are similar. Likewise, audiometric technicians/audiology aides, certified podiatric assistants, and speechlanguage pathology assistants are all SOC coded as medical assistants (31-9092) in part because their job duties are similar and in part because there are not separate codes for each.

Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRN) SOC^a 29-1171

Education and Licensing Requirements

Requirements

- 1. Completion of a graduate or post-graduate level advanced practice registered nurse educational program.
- 2. Provide documentation verifying national certification in the advanced practice registered nurse role and at least one population focus area of practice for which they are educationally prepared. The program should be nationally accredited by the American Board of Nursing Specialties (ABNS) or the National Commission for Certifying Agencies (NCCA).
- 3. Pass a mandatory criminal background check.

- 2. Graduate from a Physician Assistant training program accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP).
- 3. Satisfactorily complete a certification examination administered by the National Commission on the Certification of Physician Assistants (NCCPA).
- 4. Complete an application including the supervising Physician application.
- 5. Three original references, including two from physicians with whom the applicant has practiced.
- 6. A supervising agreement form must be submitted by the supervising physician, including a detailed description of medical practice and duties of physician's assistant under supervising physician's scope of practice as well as method of supervision.
- 7. The applicant for physician assistant licensure is required to appear before the advisory council for initial licensure


