R&P collects, analyzes, and publishes timely and accurate labor market information (LMI) meeting established statistical standards.


OUR CUSTOMERS:

Figure: Crude Oil Price, United States Dollar Per Barrel, January 2005 to July 2016





Figure: Employees on Nonfarm Payrolls by State* in Thousands, July 2015





Figure: Not Seasonally Adjusted Employee Payroll Net Change* and Percent Change by State July 2015^a to July 2016^a







Figure: Number of Unique Unemployment Insurance (UI) Claimants with Continued Claims, 2001Q1 to 2016Q3






Figure: Number of Hires, Both Hires & Exits, and Total Hires in Mining in Wyoming for 2008Q3 to 2016Q1






Figure: Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rates by State, July 2015^a


Figure: Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rates by State, July 2016^a

Figure: Over-the-Year Percentage Point Change in Unemployment Rates* by State, July 2015a to July 2016a





Figure: Wyoming Unemployment Rates* by County, July 2015





Figure: Wyoming Unemployment Rates* by County, July 2016






Figure: Percentage Change in U.S. Gross Domestic Product, 2013-2020

Figure: Estimated Population and Total Number of Hires in a Calendar Year in Wyoming, Ages 16-19, 2000-2015


