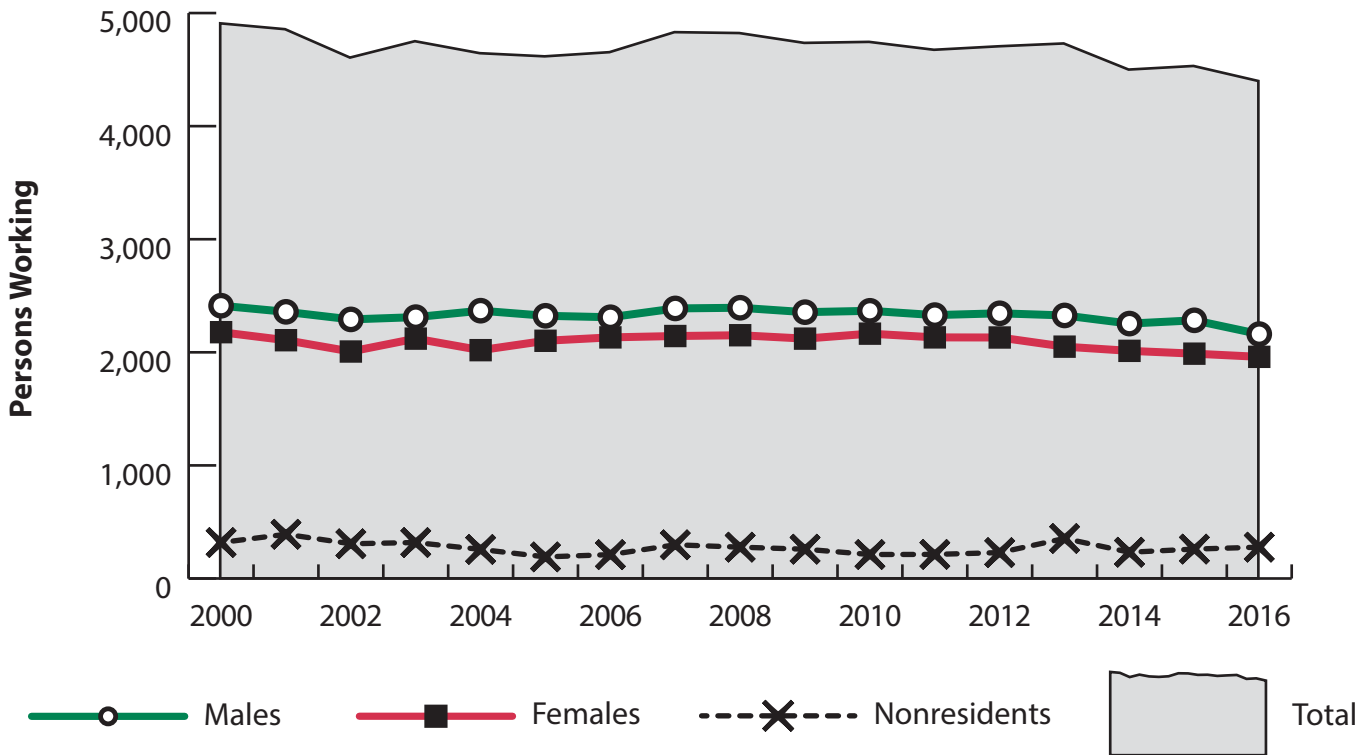
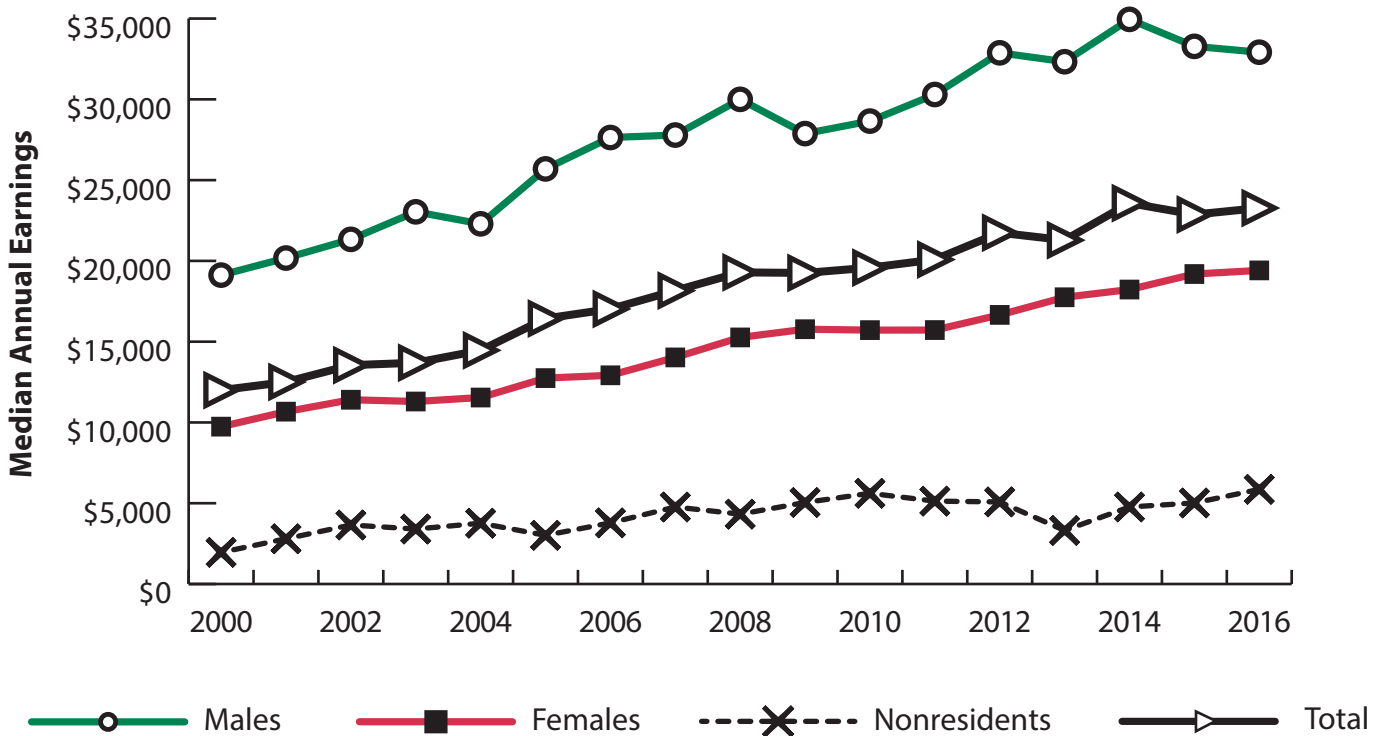


Persons Working and Average Earnings by Gender in Washakie County, WY, 2000-2016
